Chief Pour and his department were recognized for the event and taking care of personnel that attended the dedication.

Act 11L – This is a new act that allows fire chiefs to contact their local states attorney for enforcement of violation of life safety code.

SWIC – Fire suppression practicums have been ongoing. Spring 2017 classes are being worked on. Current classes being held at SWIC will not be affected by changes that are forthcoming from the OSFM on courses.

IFCA – Emails are being forwarded thru our IFCA Rep Rick Welle. Information may or may not apply.

OSFM – Greg Vespa advised the 2nd class of Juvenile Fire Setter Intervention program just wrapped up. John Hyde from IFSI has indicated that the investigator class could be hosted locally. Would just need 15 persons to make the class.

SCSESA – October 1st will be fundraiser at Swansea FD.

Red Cross - Kyle Dryer was introduced as the new chapter representative. The Red Cross will supply 10 year smoke detectors for departments to install in residences in their community.

New Business:

President Saunders appointed a nominating committee of Chief Schutzenhofer, Chief Davis, and Chief Biffer for the election of board members and officers in December. Persons interested in board positions should contact the committee.

House Bill 4522 was signed by the Governor which limited the billable amount for out of district incidents. Discussions are taking place about modifications to the amount.

Freeburg Fire Department has promoted Ron Jester to Assistant Chief.
