

Minutes of the MABAS Division 32

March 26, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 7:38 p.m. by President Saunders

Motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the January 2015 meeting. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report - The MABAS Division 32 checking account balance is \$26,836.59. \$3,300 is set aside for MABAS Illinois due. Motion was made and seconded to approve the treasurer's report. Motion passed.

New Business:

MABAS Division 32 was complimented on the presentation on civil unrest the Chief Saunders and Chief Walsh gave at the MABAS conference in February.

Chief Saunders reported on the following information from the executive board meeting.

Special teams will start completing overfill and backfill online in April. Information needs to be correct in CIMS.

Information has been received by the division that Chief Mavrogeorge approached a mutual aid group about forming a MABAS Division from existing MABAS Division 32 departments. MABAS was contacted and no information has been received from MABAS about this request.

A question was raised about the formation of the Type 3 IMT by St. Clair County. Little was known and could be answered about the team. President Saunders reminded the chiefs of the local IMT which is a type 4 that concerns itself with fire and rescues only.

Chief Walsh attended a meeting with MOSCOPE. Some discussions surrounded single resource mindset versus the task force concept. The law enforcement officials passed on information about personal information security. One resource is lifelock. There were also discussions about limiting information posted to social media.

Motion made and seconded to adjourn at 8:13 pm. Motion passed.
